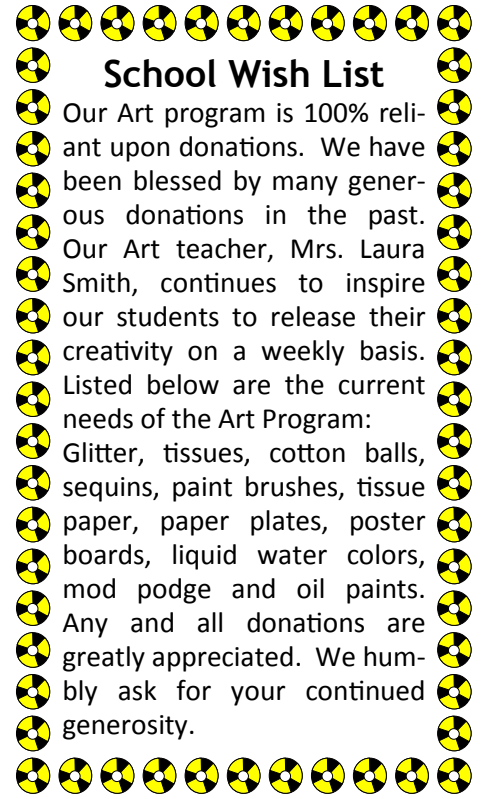

Lenten Guidelines

Abstinence: All persons who have celebrated their 14th birthday, are bound to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and all Fridays during Lent.

Fasting: Everyone from the celebration of their 18th birthday to their 59th birthday is bound to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Fasting is generally understood to mean eating one meal a day. Two other partial meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be eaten; but together they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is forbidden, but liquids are allowed.
