8th Grade Legacy Project

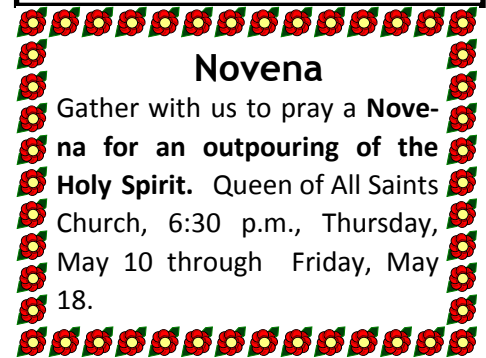
