





Car Wash




 Our 8th Grade Students will be hosting a Car Wash on Saturday, June 23rd in our back Parking Lot. The pricing is as follows:








 Key Strategies Year 1:
 Contact Michigan City Catholic parishes to assess interest in a quarterly Michigan City Catholic Community newsletter to collect pertinent information regarding Catholic liturgical, ecumenical, and social opportunities for the Catholic population of Michigan City. Cost of newsletter to be shared with participating parishes. Newsletters will be distributed to each of the four participating parishes, as well as approximately ten other locations, including hotels, tollway and interstate rest areas, the Michigan City Chamber of Commerce, Michigan City Senior Center, and the LaPorte County Convention and Visitor Center.
 Key Strategies Year 2:
 Continue to educate parishioners on information available on the My Parish App and encourage them to utilize same. Monitor increase/decrease of usage through App software.
 Key Strategies Year 3:
 Investigate additional options regarding mobile (phone) based apps dedicated to strengthening prayer and devotional life.
