2019 Mass Book



- Key Strategies Year 1:
 - Reach out to area Nursing Facilities, Veterans organizations, hospitals, etc. by our students to inspire our youth to build relationships with people of all ages and walks of life. Implement semi-annual food drives for Sacred Heart Food Pantry. Schedule Block Clean-Up each April. Coordinate an ecumenical service for School students inviting Pastors from area Christian churches who minister to our non-Catholic students and explore collaboration in community service.
- Key Strategies Year 2:
 - Collect funds to donate to one local charity during Catholi Schools Week on a rotating basis.
- Key Strategies Year 3:
 - Increase outreach to one additional local charity and expand programs from year one and two.
