Mike Eisele has volunteered to be our leader and this year we are blessed to have six new Acolytes. Also, the School has taken on several new community projects. First, they have implemented to Food drive that you have seen weekly in the bulletin. And secondly, they volunteered to help the Salvation Army with several projects this year. Another goal reached, is the implementation of a quarterly City-wide Catholic brochure. Rosemary Bunton has lead the charge for coordinating with the other Catholic Churches in town to produce this on a regular basis. Also, a Welcoming Committee has been formed.
