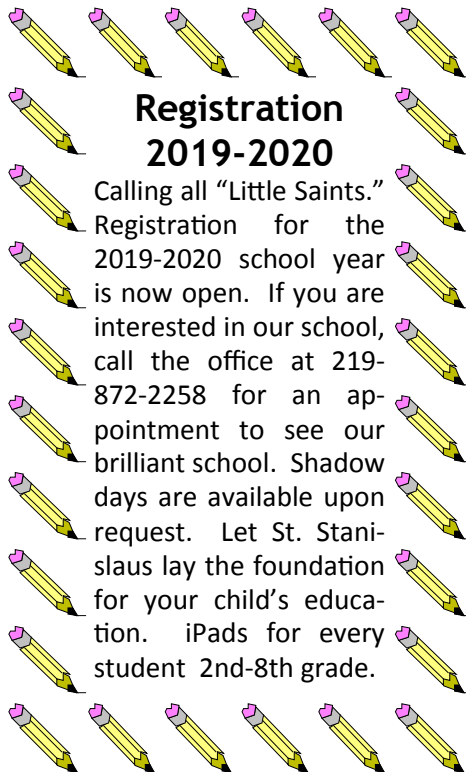
Spring Break
