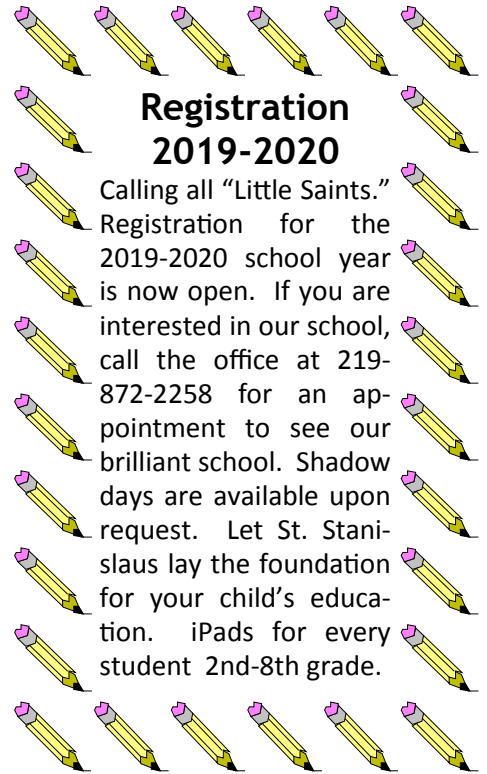

**Dear Parishioners and Friends,**

At our school Mass before the Feast of Saint Joseph I found myself struggling with breathing. On Thursday, March 28th, I was admitted to Franciscan Alliance Hospital. Tests determined that I had a blood clot in my leg and blood clots in my lungs. My right leg was badly swollen. It is good that we got to the hospital as this could have led to a possible stroke. They kept me in the hospital for a few days and placed me on a strong dosage of blood thinner. After returning home, I took some time off to rest. I will be required to be on blood thinner for the rest of my life. The medication is working. My vital signs are good. The swelling went down and my breathing has improved.
